- Water Purification
- Sleeping Bag (must pack down small) and Sleeping Pad
- Lightweight Long Underwear Top and Bottom (synthetic not cotton)
- 3 Pair Underwear
- 2 T-shirts
- 1 Lightweight Longsleeve Shirt (for bug and sunprotection)
- 1 Warm Wool or Synthetic Sweater
- 1 Pair Shorts (that dries quickly)
- 1 Long Pair of Pants (that dries quickly)
- 1 Warm Long Sleeve Wool or Synthetic Shirt or Sweater
- 1 Lightweight Jacket or Vest
- 1 Set of Waterproof Rain Gear (top and bottom)
- Boots or Shoes for the trail that can get wet and will dry easily (old athletic shoes, or rubber boots can work)
- Water Shoes or Sandals for swimming on the trail
- Comfy footwear to wear at the campsite that will always stay dry
- 3 Pair Wool Socks
- 2 Pair synthetic liner socks
- Swim Suit
- Small Towel
- Hat with Visor
- Toiletry Articles (soap, toothbrush etc...)
- Suntan Lotion (spf 30+)
- Insect Repellent

- Journal and Pen
